1. Tidy Up

This means no piles of paper, glasses, detergents, dishes, shoes and coats, fridge magnets and other eyesores. All rooms including the bathroom should be thoroughly picked up.

2. Surfaces

It is also important to tidy up all countertops. Therefore, remove all rags, brushes, pots, remote controls, newspapers and other similar objects.

3. Make beds

To create as much air as possible in front of the camera, you should also make all the beds, open all the curtains and pull up all the blinds.

4. Seasonal Decorations

Avoid seasonal decorations such as Christmas decorations.

5. Light candles

Before the photographer arrives, it is a very good idea to turn on all the lights, including candles. This gives the images a nice and cozy mood.

6. Make room

If you have lots of furniture and other items, you should remove some of them. Put some of the jackets from the overloaded coat hooks in the closets.

7. The yard

Clean up the yard. Mow the grass, remove any gardening tools.

8. Create coziness

Your photos should present your home from its best perspective. Put out flowers, hang fresh towels up, etc.
